The Operations Coordinating Board

Attached, for the consideration of the Operations Coordinating Board, is a copy of the Report of the Donovan Emergency Commission of the International Rescue Committee to Investigate Communist Redefection Campaigns. I received this Report from Mr. Leo Cherne, and have acknowledged it as indicated in the attached copy of my letter to him.

As you know, I have discussed this subject with Mr. Allen Dulles and with some of his staff. It is our preliminary conclusion that the domestic aspects of the redefection campaign are not such as to warrant Cabinet consideration at this time; if the Board should find otherwise, I shall be happy to arrange for Cabinet discussion of this problem. The President has now taken a personal interest in this Report, and has asked me to discuss it with him.

With respect to the overseas side of the campaign, I know that the Board is already dealing with this question. The attached Report may be of assistance in the Board's consideration of appropriate courses of action.

In addition to the minutes we receive from you, would you kindly keep me informed of the staff's and the Board's deliberations with respect to this Report?
